

retirement plan in Dorchester County; requiring certain eligible members of the Teachers' Retirement System or the Teachers' Pension System to elect membership in the Optional Retirement Program within a certain period of time; exempting from a certain offset of a retirement allowance certain members in the Judges' Retirement System; repealing certain provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article that set age restrictions for membership in the State Retirement and Pension System for certain individuals; providing that certain members of the Employees' Retirement System may receive a certain number of years of service credit for certain employment under certain circumstances; providing for the delayed effective date of a certain provision of this Act; providing for the application of a certain provision of this Act; providing for the termination of a certain provision of this Act; making certain technical and conforming changes; and generally relating to simplifying the administration of the State Retirement and Pension System.
