W. Woolen his executors administrators and assigns all the goods herein after particularly mentioned That is to say 12 head of Cattle, 12 head of sheep 40 and heads of hogs 1 ox Part 1 plough 2 Beds Bedsteads and furniture 1 Cupboard 7 Chairs 3 Tables all and singular which said goods and Chattels are now remaining standing and being in a certain Mesuage or tenement situated in York Neck now in the occupation of the said George Willey Do have and do hold all and singular the said goods house hold stuff and furniture and other the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended so to be, to the said Wm. W. Woolen his executors administrators and assigns forever and I the said George Willey for myself my heirs executors and administrators all and singular the said goods house hold stuff and furniture and other the premises unto the said Wm.
