Hicks, his heirs, executors or assigns, the said negro girl having to serve according to the Will of Anne Cook to the full end & term of twenty four years, from the 31st day of December, in the year Eighteen hundred & forty two, to be being all the right, title and estate of the said Edwin C. Medford, of in and to the said negro girl sold by him, for the remaining time of said girl's service.
