

CHAPTER 182

(House Bill 715)

AN ACT concerning

Patuxent Institution – Funding of Educational Programs

FOR the purpose of placing Patuxent Institution within the Division of Correction and under the jurisdiction of the Education Coordinating Council for Correctional Institutions for the funding of educational programs only; altering the membership of the Education Coordinating Council for a certain purpose; authorizing the Department of Education, in coordination with the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services, to employ teachers and librarians at Patuxent Institution on a certain basis and to alter the employment status of certain current employees; ~~making a certain section of this Act an emergency measure;~~ providing for a delayed effective date for a certain provision of this Act; and generally relating to the funding of educational programs at Patuxent Institution.
