- (a) [An applicant for a license] A LICENSEE [to participate as a boxer or kick boxer in a contest] shall be examined by a licensed physician who is chosen by the Commission and who specializes in neurology or neurosurgery PRIOR TO THE LICENSEE'S FIRST APPEARANCE AS A CONTESTANT IN A KICK BOXING OR BOXING CONTEST FOLLOWING THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE.
- (b) The Commission shall pay the cost of the neurological examination required under this section.

CHAPTER 408

(House Bill 1291)

AN ACT concerning

State Commission of Real Estate Appraisers - Examination Fees

(d) To take an examination, an applicant shall pay [a \$50 examination fee to the Commission] AN EXAMINATION FEE TO THE COMMISSION IN AN AMOUNT ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION TO COVER NOT TO EXCEED THE COST OF ADMINISTERING THE EXAMINATION
