

And part thereof to the same Joseph altho' afterwards to wit the same day and year of at the County of  
within the said Jurisdiction he was thereto requested he hath not paid nor the same Joseph for it any wise  
Contented but the same liketh to do hath altogether refused and still doth refuse to the damage of  
the same Joseph of Sixteen pound Cash and there of he bring this Suit &c

And the said William Freeman in his own proper person comes and sheweth the force and injury -  
wherein said and say that he cannot gain say the action aforesaid, nor but that he did assume upon himself in man-  
ner and form as the said Joseph above against him hath complained, Neither can he say but that the said  
Joseph hath sustained damages by reason of the Non performance of his promise and assumption aforesaid to  
Eight pound Cash and the same declaration in all the words before Expressly Confessed &c

Therefore it is considered that the said Joseph Wyatt Recover against the said William  
Freeman as well the sum of Eight pound Cash his damages aforesaid by him in his declaration above Suppo-  
sed as also Two hundred thirty one <sup>pounds of tobacco for his costs and</sup>  
charges by him about his Suit in that part Expended to the same Joseph by the Court here of his aforesaid  
adjudged and the said debt in Money &c

Ordered by the Court that William Robertson pay unto George <sup>and John Bohannon</sup> Sixty pound of tobacco Cash  
being due unto them for their attendance two days each as Evidence on behalf of the said Wm. Rob-  
ertson against J<sup>r</sup> and Henry Colke they having made oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Wm. Robertson pay unto Thomas Saper and James Diggers one hundred  
and twenty pound of tobacco Cash being due unto them for their attendance four days each as Evidence on  
behalf of said Wm. Robertson against John & Henry Colke they having made oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Rowland Bewin pay unto Benj<sup>r</sup> Full, Sarah Taylor, Mary Fleming  
Mary Mayo and <sup>and</sup> Cornelius Dickson <sup>being due unto them</sup> ninety pound of tobacco Cash for their attendance three days  
each as Evidence on behalf of the said Rowland Bewin and Mary his wife against Littelton  
Townsend they having made oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Littelton Townsend pay unto Andrew Collins Sixty pound of tobacco  
being due unto him for his attendance two days as Evidence on behalf of the said Littelton Town-  
send against Rowland Bewin and Mary his wife they having made oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Littelton Townsend pay unto Solomon Townsend and James  
Baker <sup>being due unto them</sup> ninety pound of tobacco Cash for their attendance three days each as Evidence on behalf  
of the said Littelton Townsend against Rowland Bewin and Mary his wife they having  
made oath to the same &c
