The joint committee appointed to contract for the public printing, under the provisions of the act of 1831, chapter 303, beg leave to report:

That they have contracted with Jeremiah Hughes for the printing of the laws that may be passed by the next general assembly on the following terms: 1600 copies at \$2 50 per page, each page to contain 1650 ems. That they have contracted with the same gentleman for the printing of the journal of the next house of delegates and such other public printing as may be required by that body on the following terms, viz:

Journal 1600 copies, \$2 00 per page, each page to contain 1450 ems, the ayes and noes to be in three instead of two columns as heretofore; no extra allowance to be made for the current journal.

Bills, \$1 per page—each page to contain 22 lines of six inches in length—117 copies to be furnished

Pamphlets and reports at the rate of \$1 per page 117 copies.

Broadsides at the rate of \$7 for 117 copies.
