Also, the resolution in favour of the chief and assistant Clerks of the House of Delegates and Senate, endorsed, assented to, and the resolution ordered to be engrossed;

And, delivered a bill originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, an act to authorise the appointment of commissioners, and the division of Worcester county, into school districts, and for other purposes;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Handy, Townsend, of Worcester, and Powell.

Mr. Handy, from the committee, made a favourable report on said bill;

Which was read.

The said bill was then read the second time by special order, 'passed,' and returned to the Senate;

On motion of Mr Simmons,

The house took up for consideration, the report and resolutions submitted by him on the 8th instant, in relation to the repairs and improvement of the public buildings;

Mr. Alexander, called for a division of the question upon each resolution;

The first and second resolutions were rejected by the house;

The third resolution was then read the second time;

On motion of Mr. Buchanan,

The third resolution was amended by striking out the following, 'the sum of two hundred dollars for repairing the Library chamber;

Mr. Buchanan, moved further to amend said resolution, by striking out in that part of said resolution which appropriates "three hundred dollars," for a Wood-house, and inserting "one hundred;"

Determined in the negative.

The question was then put, will the house assent to the 3d resolution as amended;

Resolved in the affirmative.

The fourth resolution was then read the second time and assented to;

The fifth resolution was then read the second time, and assented to;

The said report was then concurred in, and the resolutions therein contained sent to the senate.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, an act for the encouragement of primary schools in Prince George's county;
