Do you not know that Judge Hump is a Judge of the Circuit Court for the District of Columbia and that he is now sitting on the bench in a state of suspension and that you are sworn to give the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, so help you God, in reference to the removal of Judge Hump, and that you are not at times vulgar and undignified in your behavior on the bench? Answer: I have seen this Sheriff on the bench on the 1st of November, 1872.
