

on Executive Nominations, whose duty it shall be, unless otherwise ordered by the Senate, to examine all recommendations made to the Executive in favor of applicants for office, and all communications received by the Executive opposed to the appointment of any applicant, so far as said recommendations and communications may be communicated to said Committee by the Executive, and report thereon.

XLI.

It shall not be permitted to any Senator, in the form of an Order, Resolution, or otherwise, to place upon the Journals any observation made by himself or another, touching the character or fitness for office, of any individual.

XLII.

The forms adopted by the Committee on the Constitution, on the part of the Senate, and the Committee on the Judiciary, on the part of the House, shall be hereafter pursued in the introduction and passage of any bills.
