1st section 3d line, strike out "semi,"

1st section, 3d line, strike out the words "first week in September, and the first week in March," and insert

"Second week in July."

Section 4th 2nd line, strike out the word "twice."

Section 4th, 3d line, strike out the words "months of September and March," and insert,

"Month of July."

Section 4th, 4th line, strike out the words "each of said months," and insert,

"Said month."

Section 4th, 18th line, strike out the word "fourteen," and insert,]
"Fifteen."
