

salt. The physician may vary the diet when necessary. The cooking and the refectory shall be regulated by the Board of Directors; but no prisoner shall receive any thing but the prison allowance.

The Board of Directors shall make all rules and regulations to enforce obedience, order, and discipline among the convicts, that may be necessary in addition to those herein prescribed—and shall cause this act, and all the rules that may be adopted from time to time to be printed for the information and direction of the officers. And the officers shall not enforce any order or principle of discipline, unless the same be made previously a part of the rules and regulations, and communicated to them as such.

Sec. 27. And be it enacted, That the following acts and part of acts, and all other acts and parts of acts that are inconsistent with any thing contained in this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed, viz:
