DECEMBER SESSION, 1837.

- No 1. Resolution in favor of the members and officers of the Legislature.
2. Resolution in favor of Adam Houk.
3. Resolution relative to the East Wing of the Barracks, in Frederick town, Frederick county.
4. Resolution in favour of Rebecca Uncles.
5. Resolution requiring the sheriff of Allegany county to pay over to the treasurer of the poor school fund of said county the amount forfeited by the securities of Samuel Warwick.
6. Resolution relating to certain arms therein mentioned, to be delivered by the Governor to Captain Thomas Dowden, at Cumberland.
7. Resolution directing His Excellency, the Governor, to cause to be delivered to Captain Thomas Dowden, two hundred stand of muskets, accoutrements &c.
8. Resolution directing the Armourer at Annapolis to contract for the making of two hundred pistol cartridge boxes, and two hundred pair of holsters, and for the payment of the same.
9. Resolution requesting the Executive to have delivered certain arms for the use of Captain Benjamin Sutton.
10. Resolution in favour of Jane Bishop.
11. Resolution in favour of Walter H. S. Mitchell, administrator of John Edelen.
12. Resolution directing the Treasurer for the Western Shore to pay to members of the Council each the sum of \$250
13. Resolution in favour of Captain James C. Ninde, of the city of Baltimore, making a requisition on the Adjutant General for such arms, implements and equipments as be necessary for an artillery company.
