Whereupon it is Commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that Immediately he take the said Womney Maulmney if he be to answer &c and afterwards to wit the same day and Year Last mentioned came the said Womney Maulmney in his proper person under Custody of the Sheriff of the County aforesaid and being by the same Sheriff Led to the Bar. is thereupon Instantly ordered by the Court to give security with two good securities for his good behaviour and appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November then next &c

Whereupon the said Womney Maulmney with Joshua Caldwell and George Denton both of the County aforesaid planters his securitys all present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Womney Maulmney in forty pounds Sterling and the said Joshua Caldwell and George Denton in Twenty pounds Sterling each of their severall goods and Chattells Lands and tenements to be made and Levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors If it happen that the same Womney Maulmney Do not make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of November then next
