every where willingly he shall doe and in all thing as a good and faithfull apprentice shall demean himself towards
his said Master and all his during the term aforesaid &c.

In consideration of which service ^{the said} Isaac Holland present here in Court in his proper person Covenanteth
with the Justices of the same Court in Court Judicially sitting in manner and form following that is to say that he
