

16. An act to authorize John Spear, late collector of the second collection district of Anne Arundel county, further time to complete his collections.

17. An act to authorize Benjamin T. Pindle, collector of the first collection district of Anne Arundel county, to complete his collections of county taxes in said district.

18. An act to prohibit the sale of ardent spirits within one mile of the alms house of Anne Arundel county.

19. An act for altering the lines of school districts numbers ten and forty-eight of Anne Arundel county, and for removing the school house in district number ten.

20. An act to repeal an act entitled, an additional supplement to an act, passed at December session eighteen hundred and twenty-six, chapter two hundred and seventeen, providing for the election of commissioners for Baltimore county, and prescribing their powers and duties.

21. An act to authorize the several collectors of taxes in Baltimore county to complete their collections.

22. An act to make valid a certain deed.

23. An act to prevent nuisances in or near the town of Port Tobacco in Charles county.

24. An act for the relief of William Ireland, late collector for Calvert county.

25. An act for the benefit of the crier of Kent county court.

26. An act to incorporate the society of the Redemptorists of the city of Baltimore.

27. A supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Maryland and New York iron coal company, passed December session eighteen hundred and thirty-seven.

28. A supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road, from the square in the town of Boonsborough in Washington county, to Swearingen's Ferry on the Potomac River.

29. A supplement to an act for the cleaning out of Pocomoke River in Worcester county, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty, chapter two hundred and fifteen.

30. An act to provide for the preservation of wild fowl, oysters and terrapins, in the waters of Synnapuxent Bay in Worcester county.

31. An act to authorize the trustees of Worcester county, to receive into the alms house a negro man named Stephen Kitchens, of said county.

32. An act to authorize Eliza R. W. Waters, to make a sale and conveyance of a lot of ground to the trustees of the Washington Academy.

33. An act to incorporate the Neptune Temperance beneficial society.

34. An act to incorporate the Mount Clare total abstinence beneficial society of Baltimore.
