

TITLES OF THE LAWS.

No. 1. An act to allow further time to Stephen H. Gough, Sheriff of Saint Mary's county, to execute his bond for the year 1844.

2. An act to allow further time to Benjamin T. Pindle, Sheriff of Anne Arundel county, to execute his bond for the year 1844.

3. An act for the relief of Primary Schools in Anne Arundel county.

4. An act to allow further time to Francis Stephens, Sheriff of Calvert county, to execute his bond for the year 1844.

5. An act to repeal an act passed at December session 1842, chapter 292; entitled an act to restrain the rigor of speedy proceedings for the recovery of small debts.

6. An act for the benefit of the heirs of Thomas H. Marshall late of Charles county deceased.

7. An act giving further time to Thomas Dowden late Sheriff of Allegany county, to complete his collections.

8. An act to separate the School Fund of Howard District from that of Anne Arundel county.

9. An act to incorporate the German Union Beneficial Society of Cumberland.

10. An act to make valid the official acts of Isaac Brower and John B. Gilbert, as Justices of the Peace for Frederick county.

11. An act to authorise Isaac C. Anderson, late Sheriff and collector of taxes of Howard District, of Anne Arundel county, to continue the collection of arrears of taxes for 1841 and 1842.

12. An act to open and establish Prospect street in the town of Cumberland.

13. A supplement to an act entitled, an act for the classification of the business of the County Court of Washington county, passed at December session 1842, chapter 233.

14. An act to authorise the commissioners of Allegany county to levy a sum of money for the purpose therein mentioned.

15. An act to confirm the proceedings of certain commissioners and extend the time for making a road therein mentioned, in Baltimore county.

16. An act to divide the State into Six Congressional districts.
