III. **Provided always, and be it Enacted,** That nothing in this, or the aforesaid recited Act contained, shall be construed to take away from the Inhabitants of the said Parish, the Liberty of paying the said Assessments in Money, during the Continuance of this Act, in the same Manner as Public and County Levies may be paid and discharged.

IV. **Provided also, and be it further Enacted,** That if the said Parish shall at any Time be without an Organist, all such Sum or Sums of Tobacco as shall at such Time be levied on the Taxable Inhabitants thereof, or any Sum or Sums of Tobacco, or Money, which shall be in the Hands of the Vestry unapplied, shall be by the said Vestry applied, laid out, and expended for the Use of the said Parish, to such Purposes, and in such Manner as the Majority of the Vestry and Church-wardens shall order and direct.

C H A P. XXXII.

November.An ACT for erecting a Public School in *Frederick* County.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is reasonable, that Education should be extended equally to the several Parts of the Province, and that there should be a Public School erected in *Frederick* County, as well as the other Counties;

II. **Be it therefore Enacted,** by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That in Order to the Erecting and Building a House and other Conveniencies, for a County School, there shall be One Acre of Land purchased in *Frederick-Town*, in *Frederick* County, by the Persons hereafter named, who shall be Visitors of the said School, viz. Colonel *Thomas Cresap*, Mr. *Thomas Beattys*, Mr. *Nathan Magruder*, Captain *Joseph Chapline*, Mr. *John Darnall*, Colonel *Samuel Beall*, and the Reverend Mr. *Thomas Bacon*, which said Persons, so nominated Visitors for *Frederick* County School, shall qualify in the same Manner, and be subject to the same Penalties, and be invested with the same Rights, Privileges, Powers, and Authorities, as the Visitors of the other County Schools within this Province, and shall have Succession in like Manner.

III. **And be it further Enacted,** That of all the Duties, Taxes, and Impositions hereafter to be collected, and which, since the Twenty-ninth Day of *September* last have been Collected for the Use of the County Schools within this Province, there shall be paid by the Treasurers, to the Visitors aforesaid, or their Order, an equal Dividend, by them to be applied and expended to and for the purchasing of one Acre of Land as aforesaid, and building an House and other Conveniencies as aforesaid, and to and for the Use and Benefit of the said School, in the like Manner as the Dividends due to the other County Schools, is by Law directed to be applied.
