

purchase a Piece of Ground in *Princess-Anne-Town*, whereon they may erect and build a Chapel; and that Eight Hundred Pounds, or the Value thereof in Tobacco, may be levied on the Taxable Inhabitants of the said Parish, to be applied by the said Vestrymen and Churchwardens for that Purpose; and also that the Sum of One Hundred Pounds, or the Value thereof in Tobacco, may be levied in like Manner, for the Enlargement of *Monie* Church aforesaid, and that the same might be levied by Three equal Assessments.

C H A P.
XVI.

II. Be it therefore Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Vestry and Churchwardens of the said Parish, for the Time being, or the major Part of them, be, and are hereby authorized and impowered to purchase in Fee, in the Name of the Rector, Vestrymen, and Churchwardens of *Somerset* Parish, for the Time being, so much Land in *Princess-Anne-Town* aforesaid, as by them shall be judged necessary, not exceeding Two Acres of Land; and to treat and agree with such Person or Persons as they shall judge proper, to undertake, erect and build, and in a Workman-like Manner, compleat and finish, on the said Land so to be bought, a Chapel of Ease to the said Parish: And the said Parcel of Land, when bought, and the said Chapel, when built, shall be, and are hereby declared to be vested in the said Parish, as the Estate and Chapel of Ease to the said Parish, for the Worship and Service of GOD, in like Manner as other Lands and Chapels of Ease thereon built in other Parishes, are used and enjoyed.

A Lot of Ground in *Princess-Anne*, to be purchas'd for building a Chapel.

III. And be it further Enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Vestrymen and Churchwardens aforesaid, for the Time being, or the major Part of them, and they are hereby authorized and impowered to treat and agree with any Person or Persons that they shall judge proper, to enlarge the Parish Church at *Monie* aforesaid.

Monie Church to be Enlarg'd.

IV. And be it further Enacted, That the Vestry and Churchwardens aforesaid, for the Time being, or the major Part of them, shall be, and are hereby enabled and impowered to sell and convey, in Fee Simple, the Chapel aforesaid, called *King's-Mill-Chapel*, and the Land thereto belonging, at Public Vendue, to the highest Bidder, first giving Notice of the said Sale, by Advertisements set up at the Doors of the Court-House of the said County and Parish Church aforesaid, and to apply the Money produced by such Sale towards the Purchase of the Land aforesaid in *Princess-Anne-Town*, and the Building thereon the Chapel aforesaid.

V. And be it further Enacted, That the Justices of *Somerset* County, for the Time being, shall, and they are hereby authorized and impowered to Assess on the Taxable Inhabitants of the said Parish, the Quantity of One Hundred and Forty-four Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, by Three equal Assessments, in the Years of our Lord Seventeen Hundred and Sixty-six, Seventeen Hundred and Sixty-seven, and Seventeen Hundred and Sixty-eight, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five *per Centum* for collecting the same; which said Assessments, so as aforesaid to be made, shall be collected and levied by the Sheriff of the County aforesaid, in the same Manner as Public and County Levies are collected and levied, and by him be paid to the Vestry and Churchwardens aforesaid, for the Time being, who are hereby authorized and required to receive and apply the same to the Uses and Purposes following: *That is to say*, The Quantity of One Hundred and Twenty-eight Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, Part of the same, to and for the Use and Purpose of purchasing the Parcel of Ground in *Princess-Anne-Town*, and the building and erecting thereon the Chapel aforesaid, and the remaining

144,000^{lb} of Tobacco, to be levied in 3 Years, for carrying this Act into Execution.
