On motion the question was put, Will the senate receive the following as an amendment? In the 8th line 3d section after the word 'draw' insert 'whenever I shall be thereto requested by the owner or his agent.' Determined in the affirmative. On motion the question was put, Will the senate receive the following as an amendment? In the 6th line 4th section after the word 'any' strike out 'person' and insert 'owner.' Determined in the affirmative. On motion the question was put, Will the senate receive the following as an amendment? In the 7th line 4th section, after the word 'whenever' strike out 'he' and insert 'such owner.' Determined in the affirmative. On motion the question was put, Will the senate receive the following as an amendment? At the end of the 4th section insert 'and it shall be the duty of the said inspectors to deposit the said samples in the boxes so procured by the owner and to take care that the samples deposited in said boxes be not injured or destroyed' Determined in the affirmative. On motion the question was put, Will the senate receive the following as an amendment? Insert as the 5th section of the act "*And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the said inspectors to attend once in each fortnight in the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, October and November, in every year, for the purpose of shewing the said samples to dealers, which days shall be appointed by the levy court, and notice thereof shall be published in the *American Farmer*, as long as said paper continues to be edited, and when such paper ceases, then in as many news-papers in the district of Columbia and Baltimore, as they shall deem necessary to give information of the days so as aforesaid to be appointed, so that the dealers may have notice thereof, and the provisions of this section are hereby declared not to extend to the city and county of Baltimore.' Determined in the affirmative. On motion the question was put, Will the senate receive the following as an amendment? In the 11th line 6th section after the word 'Farmer' insert 'as long as said paper continues to be edited, and when such paper ceases then in.' Determined in the affirmative. On motion the question was put, Will the senate receive the following as an amendment? In the 11th line of same section, after the word 'inspector' insert 'or the said treasurer.' Determined in the affirmative. On motion the question was put, Will the senate receive the following as an amendment? Strike out the whole of the 7th section of the bill and insert. "*And be it enacted*, That the justices of the levy court for the several counties where inspection houses shall be located, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to allow to the inspectors so much money as may be necessary to carry into effect the provisions of this act; and the said inspectors shall from time to time report to the said levy court an account and vouchers shewing the manner in which such money shall have been expended.' Determined in the affirmative. On motion the question was put, Will the senate receive the following as an amendment? Insert as the eighth section to the bill "*And be it enacted*, That the justices of the levy court or a majority of them, shall have authority to increase the salaries they are now authorised to give the inspectors to any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, over and above the salaries they are now authorised to give, whenever said justices may think that said inspectors ought to receive such increase of salary.' Determined in the affirmative.

The bill having been read through, the question was put, Shall the bill with the amendments be engrossed for a third reading. Determined in the affirmative.

Mr. Price from the committee reports a bill concerning magistrate's judgments; which was read the first time and ordered be printed.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.

FRIDAY, JANUARY 18, 1822.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The resolution in favor of Abraham Ross, was read a third time, assented to and sent to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivers a resolution in favor of Jehu Chandler; which was read the first and by special order a second time, and referred to Messrs Claude, Miller and Price. Also a bill entitled, A further supplement to the act entitled, An act to regulate the inspection of tobacco; which was read the first time and laid on the table.

The bill concerning the Shephard's town bridge company, was read a second time and laid on the table.

The supplement to the act entitled, An act for the benefit of the trustees of Garrison Forrest academy and Franklin academy, in Baltimore county, was read a third time and will not pass, and sent to the house of delegates.

The bill for the benefit of Robert Boon, was read a second time, and referred to Messrs Price, Cockey and Orrell.

The bill to authorise Christian Kemp (as guardian of Virginia Baker and Corbin Baker) of Frederick county, to bring into this state from the state of Virginia certain negroes therein mentioned, was read a second time and laid on the table.

The bill to settle and ascertain the salaries of the members of the council for the ensuing year, with the amendment proposed by the house of delegates, was read a second and by special order a third time, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

The bill to regulate the pay of the justices of the orphans courts in the several counties therein mentioned, was read a third time, and referred to Messrs Miller, Bowie and Price.
