Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That when any injunction which has heretofore issued or shall hereafter issue from the Court of Chancery or any County Court as a Court of Equity, or when any receiver or receivers have been or shall be ordered or appointed by the Court of Chancery or County Court as a Court of Equity, it shall be lawful for the defendants in the case, or any of them, to appeal from the granting of such injunction or from the refusal to dissolve the same, or from the order or
