

£. 2949 16 10 on account of tax, £. 13 10 specie and £. 3805 4 11 in bills of credit emitted May 10, 1781, on account of specific taxes, also, £. 8195 2 4 in said bills on account of sinking fund, £. 2845 5 in bills of credit emitted by congress March 18, 1780, and £. 694 7 in bills of credit emitted June 1780, on account of 7/8 fund tax; from the lieutenants of the several counties, £. 298 14 in bills of credit emitted May 10, 1781.

That it also appears to your committee, the said treasurer hath received from the naval officers, for tonnage and duties on exports and imports, £. 1245 3 8 in bills of credit emitted June 1780, £. 1124 17 3 in bills of credit emitted by congress March 18, 1780, £. 523 15 6 in bills of credit emitted May 10, 1781, and £. 52 9 8 specie; for marriage licences, £. 595 4 in bills of credit emitted by congress March 18, 1780; for ordinary licences, £. 203 7 5 in bills of credit emitted June 1780, and £. 807 8 7 in bills of credit emitted by congress March 18, 1780; for fines and forfeitures, £. 17 5 in bills of credit emitted June 1780, £. 1 2 6 in bills of credit emitted March 1780, and £. 7 15 in bills of credit emitted May 10, 1781; for commissions of letters of marque, £. 21 in bills of credit emitted June 1780, and £. 99 in bills of credit emitted March 1780.

That your committee find, certificates agreeable to the act to adjust the debts due from this state, have been issued to sundry persons to the amount of £. 16925 15 4; certificates agreeable to the act proposing to the citizens of this state, creditors of congress on loan-office certificates, to the amount of £. 19097 17 1 $\frac{1}{2}$; and certificates for the payment of the journals of account paid sundry claimants to the amount of £. 625 5 7.

That certificates issued according to the acts of assembly of this state, have been discounted with the collectors thereof to the amount of £. 5158 4 7 continental currency, and £. 12543 9 10 specie, on account of taxes; and that officers and soldiers certificates, to amount of £. 10076 14 11 have been received on account of confiscated property sold for their redemption.

That your committee have counted and burnt the sum of £. 4624 11 4 of the bills of credit emitted by an act of assembly June 1780; £. 6064 19 10 of the money made by congress March 18, 1780; and £. 17794 18 9 of the bills of credit emitted May 10, 1781.

That it appears to your committee, by the accounts of said treasurer, he hath paid away, from the 16th of November 1782, the date of the last report, to the 10th of May 1783 inclusive, the sum of £. 14635 3 8 specie, for all which payments have been produced to your committee the necessary vouchers and receipts; and that there remains in the office the sum of £. 49 appropriated for the redemption of the continental state money, and £. 226 1 1 subject to the orders of the governor and council.

That it appears to your committee, by the last report, there was remaining in the office the sum of £. 1 3 10 specie, appropriated for the redemption of the officers and soldiers certificates; £. 308 15 10, for the redemption of the bills of credit emitted May 10, 1781; also the sum of £. 8823 15 5 of the money made by congress March 18, 1780, appropriated for the purpose of calling out of circulation the bills of credit emitted by acts of assembly and resolves of convention of this state; and £. 3614 8 4 in said bills paid in on account of British creditors; which sums still remain unapplied.

Your committee have also examined the accounts of tobacco with said treasurer, and find, by an account settled by the committee of claims, November 16, 1782, there was a balance of 1325 hhd. of crop tobacco, containing 1,33,750 pounds net, and 98,730 pounds of transfer tobacco, remaining in the office; also 292,820 pounds of transfer tobacco in the hands of the commissioners of the tax.

That it appears to your committee, there hath been received from the treasurer of the eastern shore, 195 hhd. of crop tobacco, net weight 196,571 lb, and 24,818 lb of transfer tobacco; from Russell and Gilbre 1 hhd. net weight 1004 lb; from Richard Cromwell, for the purchase of escheat lands, 17 hhd. net weight 16,800 lb; for so much transfer cropped, 6 hhd. net weight 6113 lb; and from the collectors of the tax of the several counties, 518 hhd. net weight 529,630 lb, and 73,582 lb of transfer tobacco.

That it also appears to your committee by said accounts, there hath been paid away, from the 16th of November 1782 to the 10th of May 1783 inclusive, 857 hhd. net weight 874,195 lb, and 41,423 lb of transfer tobacco hath been delivered to the commissioners of the tax to be cropped, for which payments have been produced to your committee the necessary vouchers and receipts; and that there remains in the treasury 1205 hhd. of crop tobacco, net weight 1,189,673 lb, and 155,707 lb of transfer tobacco; also the quantity of 328,130 lb of transfer tobacco remains in the hands of the commissioners of the tax of the several counties to be cropped.

Your committee beg leave further to report, that they have examined the books in the old loan-office, and find there is due, on the several bonds taken by the commissioners, in virtue of an act of assembly, passed at November session 1769, for bills of credit, bills of exchange, and gold and silver, lent out on bond to sundry persons, on interest at 4 per cent. per annum, and compared the same with a list thereof now remaining in the office ready for the inspection of the honourable house, amounting to £. 4683 5 6 sterling; and that by accounts in said office it appears,
