A resolution in favor of the Maryland Institute, for the promotion of Mechanic Arts.

A resolution providing a compensation for the services of the Chaplains of both branches of the Legislature, respectively.

A resolution, with its preamble, in favor of John Morris, of Baltimore county

A resolution in favor of James Gaskins, of the city of Baltimore. And,

A resolution authorising the State Librarian to dispose of extra sets of the Laws of Maryland, including Kilty's Index, now in the State Library; and the proceeds thereof to be expended in the purchase of other law books, severally endorsed; assented to.

Ordered, That the said bills, with their respective amendments, and amendments, and the resolutions above mentioned, be severally engrossed. Also,

An act to incorporate the Baltimore Hebrew Congregation, in the city of Baltimore; endorsed, 'will pass with the proposed amendments'

Which amendments were read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table. Also,

An act to confirm and make valid a deed therein mentioned

An additional supplement to the act, of December session, 1827, chapter 117, entitled, an act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries, and others.

An act to abolish all such parts of the constitution and form of Government of this state, as provide for the election of four delegates to the General Assembly of Maryland, from each of the several counties of this state, and two from the city of Annapolis; and also all such parts thereof as provide for the election of the Senate of Maryland by electors, and the mode of filling vacancies in that body.

A supplement to the act, entitled an act, to incorporate the trustees of the public school, in Middletown, in Frederick county, passed at December session, one thousand eight hundred and twenty two.

An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from New Market, in Frederick county, to Leesborough, in Montgomery county.

An act for regulating and inspecting dry measures, used in the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes.
