

Mr. Annan reported a bill, entitled, an act to continue an act, entitled, an act for the despatch of business in Frederick County court, passed December session, 1829, and its supplements;

Which was read the first and second time by special order, passed, and sent to the senate.

Mr. Pratt reported a bill, entitled, an act to authorise the recording of a deed from James Carrol, of Baltimore city, to Robert D. Sewall, of Prince George's county;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Messrs. Carpenter and Sutton, the committee appointed to wait on his Excellency the Governor, and inform him that a quorum of the House having convened, were ready to proceed to business, and receive any communication he might be pleased to lay before them, reported that the committee had performed the duties of their appointment, and that the Governor had answered, that he would transmit a communication to the House to day at half past 12 o'clock.

The clerk of the Council delivered the following communication from the Executive:

Mr. Heard submitted the following order;

Ordered that five hundred copies of the Executive Message be printed for the use of the house,

Which was read.

Mr. Duckett moved to amend said order, by striking out the words "five hundred," and inserting in lieu thereof "one thousand."

Determined in the negative.

The said order was then read the second time and adopted;

The hour of one o'clock having arrived;

On motion of Mr. Heard, the House was called, and the Doorkeeper sent for the absent members, who after a short time had elapsed, returned and reported that all the members were in attendance.

The house then proceeded by ballot to the election of Register of Wills for Saint Mary's county, in conformity with arrangement made with the Senate for that purpose, and the ballots of the members being collected in the ballot box, it was sealed up and delivered to the committee appointed on the part of this House, to meet the committee on the part of the Senate, to count the joint ballot of both Houses and report the result, who having retired to the conference room, after a short time had elapsed, returned
